

# KNOW SOMEONE WHO NEEDS HELP?

## Student Care Financial Assistance



Do you know families who have difficulties paying their children's student care fees? Do you know children who are not in student care because their parents cannot afford the fees? Inform them that the Student Care Fee Assistance Scheme (SCFA) can help them so that their children can go to a student care centre.

### WHAT SCFA PROVIDES

SCFA provides a subsidy for your child's student care centre fee every month. The amount of subsidy will depend on the type of student care centre your child attends and your household income, as shown in the table below:

SCFA Subsidies (with effect from July 2009):

Monthly Household Income	Monthly Subsidy (Regular SCCs)	Monthly Subsidy (Special SCCs)
Less than or equal to \$1,500	Up to \$180	Up to \$379
\$1,501-\$2,000	Up to \$120	Up to \$256
\$2,001 - \$2,500	Up to \$60	Up to \$133



### WHO CAN APPLY

- Children who are Singapore citizens. Children who are Permanent Residents of Singapore (PR) can apply if at least one member of their immediate family is a Singapore citizen;
- Children who are between 7 and 14 years of age and are attending MOE-registered schools;
- Children whose mother/single father is working full-time or part-time regularly; and
- Children whose family monthly income is \$2,500 or below.

### WHERE TO APPLY

You can apply at student care centres that are registered SCFA providers.
